Camp will serve meals buffet-style in the Dining Hall for groups of 20 people or more. Vegetarian options are available upon request. No Dining Hall meals will be prepared on major holidays.

Another 25% of your total estimated lodging and/or meeting space cost

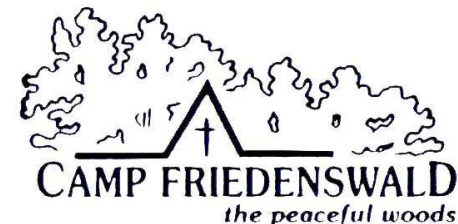
Meal Deposit:

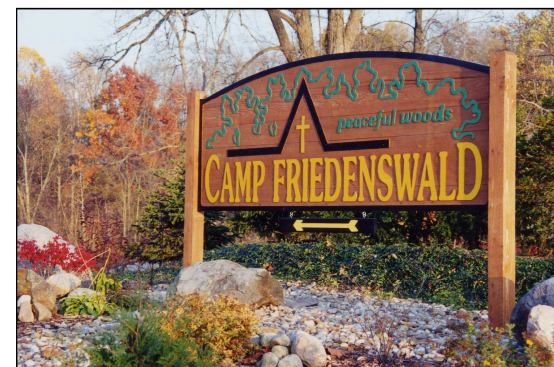

Overnight Facilities

Lakeview Lodge

Peak Season (May 25-Sept. 7) **\$730/night**

Off-Peak Season

Weekend (Friday-Saturday nights) **\$695/night**

Weekday (Sunday-Thursday nights) **\$415/night**

(Weekday rates do not apply December 21-31)

The Lakeview has eight bedrooms, two of these rooms are fully handicap accessible. Each bedroom has three bunk beds (the bottom of one being a queen size bed) and a private bath. The large central lounge includes a fireplace, game room, and a spacious kitchen. A private beach is located across from the lodge. We recommend 6 people in each room, or up to 7 people for family groups.

Capacity: 48-56 people

Tamarack Lodge

Peak Season (May 25-Sept. 7) **\$415/night**

Off-Peak Season

Weekend (Friday-Saturday nights) **\$390/night**

Weekday (Sunday-Thursday nights) **\$235/night**

(Weekday rates do not apply December 21-31)

The Tamarack features a wood-burning stove, a loft with a ping pong table and an outdoor deck, a full kitchen and a deck overlooking the Fen. Each of the four bedrooms has one double bed, one bunk bed, a private bath and a loft with a double mattress. The bedrooms open into a common lounge and dining area. A private beach is located across from the lodge.

Capacity: 24 people (16 on main level and 8 in lofts)

Sycamore Lodge

Peak Season (May 25-Sept. 7) **\$405/night**

Off-Peak Season

Weekend (Friday-Saturday nights) **\$380/night**

Weekday (Sunday-Thursday nights) **\$225/night**

(Weekday rates do not apply December 21-31)

The Sycamore is a two-story building located on main camp. The upper level contains a small common area and four bedrooms, each with a private bath and single mattress loft. Each bedroom has two bunk beds; in two of the bedrooms, one of the bottom bunks is a double bed. On the lower level is a full kitchen, eating area, bathroom and a bedroom (with a double bed and a bunk bed).

Capacity: 26 people (22 on main level and 4 in lofts)

Guesthouse Rooms \$65/night

The Guesthouse has nine individual rooms each with a private bath. Each room has two bunks, one with a double bed on the bottom. Rooms may be rented individually. We recommend four people to a room, or up to five for families.

Capacity: 4-5 people per room

The Guesthouse Rooms are generally not available June 1 through mid-July.

Modern Cabins \$90/night

These six modern handicap accessible cabins are clustered in one area on main camp. Each has an interior bathroom and porch. These cabins have five bunk beds with the bottom of one being a queen size bed.

Capacity: 10-11 people

Rustic Cabins \$70/night

These cabins are clustered in a group of six in one area on main camp. Each cabin has five sets of bunk beds and all are winterized. A central bathhouse is located nearby.

Capacity: 10 people per cabin

Dorms \$85/night

The two dorms are located in the Chapel/Activity Center. Each dorm has 7 bunk beds. Bathrooms for men and women are located within the building.

Capacity: 14 people per dorm

RV Sites \$15/night

Tent Sites \$10/night

There are 5 full hookup sites with water, electric and sewer available as well as access to the bathhouse nearby. We also have several primitive tenting sites available on Main Camp and Round Lake properties. There are no modern bathroom facilities at these sites.

Day Use \$5/person or \$10/family

Groups and individuals may use Camp's grounds for their day activities such as picnics, trail hiking, canoeing, snow tubing, etc. Please call in advance to assure your visit complies with camp's schedule.

With a 1 night stay in a lodge on a weekend, groups will be charged 1.5 times the normal rate and may stay an additional 8 hours before or after the standard check-in and out times.

Meeting Facilities

Friedenswald has several facilities which are ideal meeting spaces. Groups may enjoy coffee and tea at no additional charge in the Dining Hall. Camp has flip charts, an overhead projector, screens, and TV//DVD available for use at no extra charge.

Main Dining Hall \$150/day

Availability is based on meal schedules. It can hold a group of up to 200 people around tables.

North Dining Hall \$75/day

Partitioned off from the Dining Hall, this area can hold up to 50 people around tables or 70 on chairs.

Dining Hall Lounge \$50/day

Comfortable room with sofa and piano and toys/books for small children. It can hold 12 people around tables or 30 on chairs.

Lakeview Lodge \$150/day

The central room of Lakeview can hold up to 60 people around tables. A great view of the lake is included!

Tamarack Lodge \$130/day

The central room of Tamarack can hold up to 25 people around tables. Windows face the Tamarack fen.

Sycamore Lodge \$100/day

The lower-level room of Sycamore can hold up to 25 people around tables.

Chapel/Activity Center \$25/hour

The availability of the Chapel/Activity Center depends on program camp schedule. It can hold a group of 150 people on chairs. This fee is for exclusive use.

Meeting Place \$25/day

This is a closed in gazebo that can hold a group of 12 people around tables or 20 on chairs.

* Groups staying overnight can schedule a meeting space at no extra charge based on availability at time of rental.
