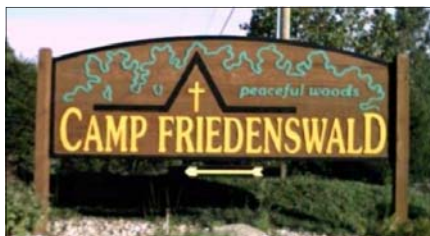


Summer Schedule

LEADERSHIP POSITIONS

Activities Coordinator (1 person)

Requires organizational skills with experience in camping and recreation. Will be part of the Leadership Team in planning overall Summer Camp Program which includes planning scheduling activities and special events. Will assist with camper orientation, and staff meetings. Will also work in other areas as needed (i.e. recreation, dishes, maintenance, etc.)

Waterfront Director (1 person)

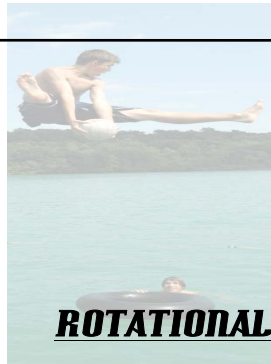
Must have lifeguard certifications (contact camp for details). Responsible for scheduling and directing the waterfront staff; ensuring order and safety on the waterfront for campers and staff, and maintaining the waterfront facilities and equipment. Will also work in other areas as needed (i.e. recreation, dishes, maintenance, etc.)

Food Service Intern (1-2 people)

This individual will help plan, prepare, take inventory, and schedule staff for Camp meals. Great work experience for nutrition majors.

Worship Leader & Worship Team (2 people)

Plan and lead creative Christian curriculum for youth camps, Music Camp, and family camps. Skills in public speaking, drama, storytelling, leading music, and discussion leading. Guitar and other instrumental playing skills helpful. Will lead morning quests, evening camp fires, and assist with camper spiritual development by helping a visiting summer camp pastor. Will also coordinate meal-time leadership (grace, announcements, mail, after-dinner singing, etc.)



ROTATIONAL POSITIONS (UP TO 25)

What does **rotational** mean? Your assignment will vary from week to week, depending on the needs of the program. We strive to match your skills and interests indicated. The variety of experiences helps to prevent "burnout" and can help you learn new skills, as well.

Cabin Counselors (a minimum of six males; six females needed each week). Must be 18 years old. Enthusiastic, service attitude, willingness and desire to work with youth. Directly responsible for: supervision, safety, spiritual development and enjoyment of approximately 7 campers assigned to your care (cabin group). Make a difference in the life of a camper!

Waterfront Assistants

Preference given to Red Cross lifeguards. Supervise waterfront swim times and activities, oversee safety procedures, and assist with routine maintenance of waterfront area.

Food Service (Kitchen) Assistants

Help prepare and cook meals for campers. Friedenswald food is outstanding! Enjoy the challenge and satisfaction of working with others and cooking food.

Maintenance Assistant

Help the maintenance director in various tasks (including routine repairs, mowing, yard work, painting, carpentry, housekeeping, etc.)

*Waterfront, food service, child care, maintenance, and are all able to participate in recreation, campfire, and evening activities. Support staff also serve as CABIN BUDDIES and assist counselors with their groups.



OTHER SUMMER STAFF POSITIONS

Camp Photographer (1 person)

Must have experience with digital photography. Organize and direct camp photography; staff photographs, weekly camp photographs, weekly activities, and special events. Oversee ordering of weekly all-camp photos. Oversee digital photography. Develop a weekly Power point slideshow. Label and place weekly photos in the summer camp photo album.



Maintenance Assistant (full summer)

Work full-time with maintenance staff. Help coordinate weekly tasks and upkeep of buildings and grounds. Participate in recreation and evening camp activities. Skills in electrical wiring, carpentry, and auto maintenance are especially welcomed, but not necessary.
